# **SENATE BILL 1223**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2417, 28-2418, 28-2419, 28-2420, 28-2421, 28-2422, 28-2423, 28-2424, 28-2425, 28-2426 AND 28-2427, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2417, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 28-2417. Child abuse prevention special plates

5 A. ~~Beginning no later than January 1, 2000,~~ The department of  
6 transportation shall issue child abuse prevention special plates. The  
7 director of the division for children in the governor's office or the  
8 director's designee shall design the child abuse prevention special plates.  
9 The design and color of the child abuse prevention special plates are subject  
10 to the approval of the department of transportation.

11 B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for  
12 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
13 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

14 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
15 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
16 established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected pursuant to this  
17 section in the prevention of child abuse fund established by section 41-109.

18 Sec. 2. Section 28-2418, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

19 28-2418. Navajo nation special plates

20 A. ~~If by June 30, 2003, the Navajo nation pays thirty two thousand~~  
21 ~~dollars to the department for the implementation of this section,~~ The  
22 department shall issue Navajo nation special plates. The color and design of  
23 the Navajo nation special plates shall be different from the color and design  
24 of regular license plates determined by the license plate commission pursuant  
25 to section 28-2351 and shall be representative of the Navajo nation.

26 B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the  
27 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
28 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

29 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
30 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
31 established by section 28-6991 and shall transmit all donations collected  
32 pursuant to this section to the Navajo nation department of highway  
33 safety. The Navajo nation department of highway safety shall use these  
34 monies only for traffic control devices that conform to the manual and  
35 specifications prescribed in section 28-641 on highways on the Navajo  
36 reservation that are located in this state and that are not state highways.

37 Sec. 3. Section 28-2419, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

38 28-2419. Transplantation awareness special plates; fund

39 A. ~~If, by June 30, 2004, a private coalition that is qualified under~~  
40 ~~section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code for federal~~  
41 ~~income tax purposes and that has a mission of promoting transplantation~~  
42 ~~awareness pays the department of transportation thirty two thousand dollars~~  
43 ~~for the implementation of this section~~ The department shall issue  
44 transplantation awareness special plates. The color and design of the  
45 transplantation awareness special plates shall be different from the color

1 and design of regular license plates determined by the license plate  
2 commission pursuant to section 28-2351.

3 B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for  
4 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
5 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

6 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
7 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
8 established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected pursuant to this  
9 section in the transplantation awareness fund established by this section.

10 D. The transplantation awareness fund is established consisting of  
11 monies received pursuant to this section. The director shall administer the  
12 fund.

13 E. The director shall select a private coalition that is qualified  
14 under section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code for  
15 federal income tax purposes and that has a mission of promoting  
16 transplantation awareness and allocate the monies in the fund to the  
17 coalition on an annual basis.

18 F. On notice from the director, the state treasurer shall invest and  
19 divest monies in the fund as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned  
20 from investment shall be credited to the fund.

21 G. Monies in the fund are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190  
22 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

24 28-2420. San Carlos Apache tribe special plates

25 A. ~~If by December 31, 2004, the San Carlos Apache tribe pays~~  
26 ~~thirty-two thousand dollars to the department for the implementation of this~~  
27 ~~section,~~ The department shall issue San Carlos Apache tribe special plates.  
28 The color and design of the San Carlos Apache tribe special plates shall be  
29 different from the color and design of regular license plates determined by  
30 the license plate commission pursuant to section 28-2351 and shall be  
31 representative of the San Carlos Apache tribe.

32 B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the  
33 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
34 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

35 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
36 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
37 established by section 28-6991 and shall transmit all donations collected  
38 pursuant to this section to the San Carlos Apache tribe transportation board.  
39 The San Carlos Apache tribe transportation board shall use these monies only  
40 for traffic control devices that conform to the manual and specifications  
41 prescribed in section 28-641 on highways on the San Carlos Apache tribe  
42 reservation that are located in this state and that are not state highways.

14 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
15 established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected pursuant to this  
16 section in the breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic special  
17 plate fund established by section 36-119.

18 Sec. 8. Section 28-2424, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:  
19 28-2424. Golden rule special plates

20 A. ~~If, by December 31, 2005, an incorporated nonprofit corporation in~~  
21 ~~this state that is qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the United States~~  
22 ~~internal revenue code for federal income tax purposes provides proof~~  
23 ~~satisfactory to the director that the corporation provides golden rule~~  
24 ~~programs that demonstrate the promotion of the golden rule in schools in this~~  
25 ~~state and in communities in this state pays thirty two thousand dollars to~~  
26 ~~the department for implementation of this section, The department shall issue~~  
27 ~~golden rule special plates. The secretary of state or the secretary of~~  
28 ~~state's designee INCORPORATED NONPROFIT CORPORATION THAT PROVIDED THE~~  
29 ~~THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION shall design~~

5 ~~section,~~ The department shall issue White Mountain Apache tribe special  
6 plates. The color and design of the White Mountain Apache tribe special  
7 plates shall be different from the color and design of regular license plates  
8 determined by the license plate commission pursuant to section 28-2351 and  
9 shall be representative of the White Mountain Apache tribe. The director may  
10 allow a request for White Mountain Apache tribe special plates to be combined  
11 with a request for personalized special plates. If the director allows such  
12 a combination, the request shall be in a form prescribed by the director and  
13 is subject to the fees for the personalized special plates in addition to the  
14 fees required for White Mountain Apache tribe special plates.

15           B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the

29           28-2426. Arizona professional baseball club special plates; fund

30           A. ~~If, by December 31, 2006, thirty-two thousand dollars is paid to~~  
31 ~~the department for the implementation of this section,~~ The department shall  
32 issue Arizona professional baseball club special plates. The entity that  
33 provides the thirty-two thousand dollars shall design the Arizona  
34 professional baseball club special plates. The design and color of the  
35 Arizona professional baseball club special plates are subject to the approval  
36 of the department. The director may allow a request for Arizona professional  
37 baseball club special plates to be combined with a request for personalized  
38 special plates. If the director allows such a combination, the request shall  
39 be in a form prescribed by the director and is subject to the fees for the  
40 personalized special plates in addition to the fees required for Arizona  
41 professional baseball club special plates.

42           B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the  
43 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
44 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

1 C. The department shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
2 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the state highway fund  
3 established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected pursuant to this  
4 section in the Arizona professional baseball club special plate fund  
5 established by subsection D of this section.

6 D. The Arizona professional baseball club special plate fund is  
7 established consisting of monies received pursuant to this section. The  
8 director shall administer the fund. The first thirty-two thousand dollars  
9 received shall be reimbursed to the entity that paid the implementation fee  
10 to the department pursuant to subsection A of this section. Not more than  
11 ten per cent of monies deposited in the fund annually shall be used for the  
12 cost of administering the fund. Monies in the fund are continuously  
13 appropriated. The director shall allocate monies from the fund through a  
14 private Arizona professional baseball organization's foundation that is  
15 qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code  
16 for federal income tax purposes and that further allocates the monies to  
17 programs relating to youth education and development, housing for the  
18 homeless or low-income persons and health care for the indigent. The  
19 director shall forward all monies deposited in the Arizona professional  
20 baseball club special plate fund, excluding administrative fees, to the  
21 foundation on an annual basis.

22 E. On notice from the director, the state treasurer shall invest and  
23 divest monies in the fund as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned  
24 from investment shall be credited to the fund.

25 Sec. 11. Section 28-2427, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
26 read:

27 28-2427. Families of fallen police officers special plates

28 A. ~~If, by December 31, 2006, thirty-two thousand dollars is paid to~~  
29 ~~the department of transportation for the implementation of this section,~~ The  
30 department of transportation shall issue families of fallen police officers  
31 special plates. The entity that provides the thirty-two thousand dollars  
32 shall design the families of fallen officers special plate. The design and  
33 color of the families of fallen police officers special plates are subject to  
34 the approval of the department of transportation. The director of the  
35 department of transportation may allow a request for families of fallen  
36 police officers special plates to be combined with a request for personalized  
37 special plates. If the director of the department of transportation allows  
38 such a combination, the request shall be in a form prescribed by the director  
39 of the department of transportation and is subject to the fees for the  
40 personalized special plates in addition to the fees required for families of  
41 fallen police officers special plates.

1           B. Of the twenty-five dollar fee required by section 28-2402 for the  
2 original special plates and for renewal of special plates, eight dollars is a  
3 special plate administration fee and seventeen dollars is an annual donation.

4           C. The department of transportation shall deposit, pursuant to  
5 sections 35-146 and 35-147, all special plate administration fees in the  
6 state highway fund established by section 28-6991 and all donations collected  
7 pursuant to this section in the families of fallen police officers special  
8 plate fund established by section 41-1721.
