REPEALING SECTION 41-3007.10, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3012.17; RELATING TO THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3012.17, to read:
6 41-3012.17. Automobile theft authority; termination July 1,

8 A. THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2012.
9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 31 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2013.
10 Sec. 3. Purpose
11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, Arizona Revised Statutes, the legislature
12 continues the automobile theft authority to provide assistance to law
13 enforcement with funding and programs to reduce the incidence of automobile
14 theft in Arizona.
15 Sec. 4. Retroactivity
16 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
17 2007.
