CHAPTER 32

SENATE BILL 1161

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-737, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO HIGH OCCUPANCY
VEHICLE LANES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 28-737, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-737. High occupancy vehicle lanes; civil penalty;
5 definitions

6 A. Except as provided in section 28-2416 and subsections B, ~~and~~ C, D
7 AND E of this section, a person shall not drive a vehicle carrying fewer than
8 two persons, including the driver, in a high occupancy vehicle lane at any
9 time the use of the high occupancy vehicle lane is restricted to vehicles
10 carrying two or more persons, including the driver.

11 B. If the department receives approval from the federal government
12 allowing the use of high occupancy vehicle lanes by hybrid vehicles, a person
13 may drive a hybrid vehicle with alternative fuel vehicle special plates, or
14 an alternative fuel vehicle sticker, and a hybrid vehicle sticker issued
15 pursuant to section 28-2416 in high occupancy vehicle lanes at any time,
16 regardless of occupancy level, without penalty.

17 C. During the performance of a tow truck operator's duties, a tow
18 truck operator may drive a tow truck in a high occupancy vehicle lane,
19 regardless of occupancy level, without penalty.

20 D. A PERSON MAY DRIVE A MOTORCYCLE IN A HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE LANE AT
21 ANY TIME REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS, WITHOUT PENALTY.

22 E. A PERSON MAY DRIVE A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE IN A HIGH
23 OCCUPANCY VEHICLE LANE AT ANY TIME REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS,
24 WITHOUT PENALTY.

25 ~~D.~~ F. A person who violates subsection A of this section is subject
26 to a civil penalty of two hundred dollars.

27 ~~E.~~ G. Notwithstanding section 28-1554, one hundred dollars of each
28 civil penalty collected pursuant to subsection ~~D.~~ F of this section shall be
29 deposited in the state general fund.

30 ~~F.~~ H. For the purposes of this section: ~~—~~

31 1. "Hybrid vehicle" means a factory-manufactured vehicle that
32 satisfies all of the following:

33 ~~1.~~ (a) Combines two or more power train technologies to produce a
34 vehicle with significantly lower fuel consumption than the average of its
35 class.

36 ~~2.~~ (b) Exhibits the storage of kinetic energy by use of regenerative
37 braking and batteries or capacitors, and the stored energy is used to assist
38 or provide full acceleration of the vehicle.

39 ~~3.~~ (c) Allows a portion of the energy to be supplied from an internal
40 combustion engine or fuel cell for vehicle acceleration and to store
41 electrical energy on board.

42 ~~4.~~ (d) Obtains all energy required to operate from storage fuel tanks
43 placed on board the vehicle.

1 5- (e) Has been approved by the United States environmental
2 protection agency as meeting, at a minimum, the United States environmental
3 protection agency ultralow emission vehicle standard pursuant to 40 Code of
4 Federal Regulations section 88.104-94.

5 2. "PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE" MEANS ANY VEHICLE THAT PROVIDES A
6 PUBLIC ENTITY'S PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE AND EITHER:

7 (a) IS OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE PUBLIC ENTITY.

8 (b) IS OPERATED UNDER A CONTRACT WITH THE PUBLIC ENTITY.


