# **HOUSE BILL 2407**

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2005, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 3, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 350, SECTION 4; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA CENTENNIAL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 2005, chapter 1, section 3, as amended by Laws 2006,  
3 chapter 350, section 4, is amended to read:

4 Sec. 3. Arizona centennial 2012

5 A. The historical advisory commission shall develop and coordinate a  
6 statewide plan regarding this state's centennial in 2012. The plan shall  
7 include the following:

8 1. Advising the legislature and state agencies on centennial history  
9 and heritage, arts and culture and related activities.

10 2. Assisting the governor's countdown to the centennial to support  
11 school children learning about this state's history.

12 3. Recommending and funding activities and projects that will ensure  
13 lasting legacy accomplishments to commemorate the centennial.

14 B. The historical advisory commission may accept and spend  
15 appropriations, grants, gifts, contributions and devises to assist in  
16 carrying out this section. The historical advisory commission may accept and  
17 spend APPROPRIATIONS, grants, gifts, contributions and devises to contract  
18 for administrative and clerical staff, professional and administrative  
19 experts and other staff as necessary to enable the commission to carry out  
20 this section.

21 Sec. 2. Transfer of monies; Arizona centennial 2012; exemption

22 A. The sum of \$50,000 is transferred from the appropriation made to  
23 the legislative council by Laws 2006, chapter 350, section 7 in fiscal year  
24 2006-2007 to the historical advisory commission for the purposes prescribed  
25 in Laws 2005, chapter 1, section 3, as amended by Laws 2006, chapter 350,  
26 section 4 and this act. The use of the transferred monies in this subsection  
27 is not subject to the legislative council vote or the matching monies  
28 requirement of Laws 2006, chapter 350, section 7.

29 B. The transfer of monies made in subsection A of this section is  
30 exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
31 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

32 Sec. 3. Emergency

33 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
34 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
35 law.
