SENATE BILL 1129

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-3008.09, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3018.09; RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 41-3008.09, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3018.09, to read:

6 41-3018.09. Board of occupational therapy examiners;
7 termination July 1, 2018

8 A. THE BOARD OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY EXAMINERS TERMINATES ON JULY 1,
9 2018.

10 B. TITLE 32, CHAPTER 34 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2019.

11 Sec. 3. Purpose

12 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
13 the legislature continues the board of occupational therapy examiners to
14 promote the safe and professional practice of occupational therapy.

15 Sec. 4. Retroactivity

16 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
17 2008.






