SENATE BILL 1008

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 26-101, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ADJUTANT GENERAL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 26-101, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 26-101. Department of emergency and military affairs;
5 organization; adjutant general; qualifications

6 A. ~~There is established a~~ THE department of emergency and military
7 affairs ~~which shall consist~~ IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING of a division of
8 emergency management and other divisions or offices as determined by the
9 adjutant general pursuant to section 26-102, subsection C, paragraph 8.

10 B. The department shall consist of the adjutant general and such other
11 officers, warrant officers, enlisted personnel and employees as deemed
12 necessary.

13 C. The department shall be administered and controlled by the governor
14 as commander-in-chief. The adjutant general shall be the director of the
15 department.

16 D. The adjutant general shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to
17 section 38-211 for a term of office of five years or to THE age ~~sixty-four~~
18 PROVIDED BY FEDERAL LAW RELATING TO STATE ADJUTANTS GENERAL, whichever occurs
19 first. The person appointed shall be a citizen of the United States and a
20 resident of the state of Arizona. At the time of the appointment, the person
21 appointed shall have qualifications required by the United States department
22 of defense for the adjutant general and shall attain federal recognition in a
23 grade not less than brigadier general ~~within~~ NOT LATER THAN one year ~~of~~ AFTER
24 the appointment. The adjutant general shall have served not less than five
25 years in the national guard of Arizona in the last ten years. Failure to
26 meet these qualifications or to retain federal recognition shall terminate
27 the appointment.

28 E. The adjutant general shall receive compensation as determined
29 pursuant to section 38-611, and shall devote full time to the office.

30 F. At the time of appointment, the adjutant general shall receive the
31 state rank of major general and ~~shall~~, at that time, SHALL become the ranking
32 officer in the department of emergency and military affairs.
