CHAPTER 38

HOUSE BILL 2133

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-2010, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MOTORCYCLE SAFETY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2010, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2010. Motorcycle safety fund; administration; advisory
5 council

6 A. A motorcycle safety fund is established consisting of monies
7 deposited pursuant to subsection B of this section and monies from gifts,
8 grants and other donations. The director of the governor's office of highway
9 safety shall administer the fund. On notice from the director of the
10 governor's office of highway safety, the state treasurer shall invest and
11 divest monies in the fund as provided in section 35-313, and monies earned
12 from investment shall be credited to the fund. Up to ten per cent of the
13 monies in the fund may be used for administrative costs. Monies in the fund
14 are subject to legislative appropriation and are exempt from the provisions
15 of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

16 B. Notwithstanding section 28-2004, through June 30, ~~2010~~ 2016, the
17 director of the department of transportation shall deposit, pursuant to
18 sections 35-146 and 35-147, one dollar of each motorcycle registration fee
19 collected pursuant to section 28-2003 in the motorcycle safety fund.

20 C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the director of the
21 governor's office of highway safety shall use monies deposited in the
22 motorcycle safety fund pursuant to this section, after consultation with the
23 Arizona motorcycle safety advisory council, to implement and support
24 voluntary motorcycle education, awareness and other programs, including
25 covering the cost of materials for motorcycle safety, education and awareness
26 programs.

27 D. Through June 30, ~~2010~~ 2016, the Arizona motorcycle safety advisory
28 council is established consisting of five members who have experience in
29 motorcycle safety and who are appointed by the governor for three year terms.
30 Members may be removed for cause and may be reappointed. The council shall
31 meet at least quarterly and on the call of the director of the governor's
32 office of highway safety for advice on the expenditure of monies in the
33 motorcycle safety fund.
