CHAPTER 73

SENATE BILL 1316

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND AND MAKING
NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND ASSESSMENTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; nuclear emergency management fund

3 Pursuant to sections 26-306.01 and 26-306.02, Arizona Revised Statutes,
4 the sum of \$1,523,108 in fiscal year 2009-2010 and the sum of \$1,569,091 in
5 fiscal year 2010-2011 are appropriated from the state general fund to the
6 nuclear emergency management fund for the following agencies:

7 1. For use by the division of emergency management of the department
8 of emergency and military affairs as provided in section 26-306.02, Arizona
9 Revised Statutes, the lump sum of \$420,749 and 4.5 full-time equivalent
10 positions in fiscal year 2009-2010 and \$440,805 and 4.5 full-time equivalent
11 positions in fiscal year 2010-2011.

12 2. For use by the radiation regulatory agency for programs relating to
13 off-site nuclear emergency response plans, the lump sum of \$627,991 and 4
14 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2009-2010 and \$639,548 and 4
15 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2010-2011.

16 3. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the
17 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of
18 Maricopa county assigned responsibilities under the off-site nuclear
19 emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$404,459 in fiscal year 2009-2010
20 and \$418,829 in fiscal year 2010-2011.

21 4. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the
22 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of
23 the town of Buckeye assigned responsibilities under the off-site nuclear
24 emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$69,909 in fiscal year 2009-2010 and
25 \$69,909 in fiscal year 2010-2011.

26 Sec. 2. Assessments; purpose

27 Pursuant to section 26-306.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, the sum of
28 \$1,523,108 in fiscal year 2009-2010 and \$1,569,091 in fiscal year 2010-2011,
29 plus any applicable interest, is assessed against each consortium of public
30 service corporations and municipal corporations engaged in constructing or
31 operating a commercial nuclear generating station in this state.

32 Sec. 3. Emergency

33 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
34 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
35 law.
