CHAPTER 2

SENATE BILL 1002

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 345, SECTION 7, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2008, CHAPTER 53, SECTION 29; AMENDING LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 356, SECTION 1, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2008, CHAPTER 53, SECTION 31; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; RELATING TO 2008-2009 CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET REDUCTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND TRANSFERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 2006, chapter 345, section 7, as amended by Laws 2008,
3 chapter 53, section 29, is amended to read:

4 Sec. 7. Appropriations and distributions; microwave
5 communications system; department of public safety;
6 report

7 A. The sum of \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
8 in ~~each of the fiscal years YEAR 2006-2007, and 2008-2009~~ and the sum of
9 \$1,000,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2007-2008 AND THE SUM OF \$1,250,000
10 IS APPROPRIATED IN FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 to the department of public safety
11 for the design, construction and implementation of a microwave communications
12 system upgrade.

13 B. The sum of \$826,000 is appropriated from the state highway fund in
14 each of the fiscal years 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 to the department
15 of transportation for distribution to the department of public safety for the
16 design, construction and implementation of a microwave communications system
17 upgrade.

18 C. The sum of \$207,000 is appropriated from the game and fish fund in
19 each of the fiscal years 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 to the game and
20 fish department for distribution to the department of public safety for the
21 design, construction and implementation of a microwave communications system
22 upgrade.

23 D. The department of public safety shall submit an expenditure plan
24 and project timeline to the joint legislative budget committee for review
25 before expending any monies appropriated for the microwave communications
26 system upgrade. The submission shall include the results of the project
27 investment justification approval by the information technology authorization
28 committee. The department of public safety shall submit a report to the
29 joint legislative budget committee for review regarding expenditures and
30 progress by December 31, 2006 and June 30, 2007.

31 E. It is the intent of the legislature that \$1,600,000 of federal
32 homeland security monies be distributed in each of the fiscal years
33 2006-2007, 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 to fund the department of public safety
34 microwave communications system upgrade.

35 F. Of the appropriations made in this section for the microwave
36 communications system, the department of public safety may use up to \$295,600
37 annually for up to 4 FTE positions to provide project management.

38 Sec. 2. Laws 2006, chapter 356, section 1, as amended by Laws 2008,
39 chapter 53, section 31, is amended to read:

40 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

41 A. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
42 in fiscal year ~~2008-2009~~ 2009-2010 to the department of veterans' services
43 for construction and establishment of a veterans' home facility in Tucson
44 pursuant to section 41-603, subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes.

1 C. Notwithstanding Laws 2007, chapter 257, section 5, the sums
2 appropriated for major capital projects of \$1,850,000 for de-icer buildings,
3 \$1,365,000 for oil and asphalt storage tanks, \$2,021,300 for vehicle wash
4 systems, \$3,215,000 for a Safford vehicle maintenance shop and \$5,190,000 for
5 a far southeast valley multiuse facility revert to the state highway fund on
6 the effective date of this act.

7 D. Notwithstanding Laws 2007, chapter 257, section 5, the sums
8 appropriated for major capital projects of \$1,511,900 for a far southeast
9 valley multiuse facility, \$3,956,300 for a Surprise motor vehicle division
10 service center and \$1,229,400 for a Payson motor vehicle division service
11 center revert to the Arizona highway user revenue fund on the effective date
12 of this act.

13 E. Notwithstanding Laws 2007, chapter 257, section 5, the sum of
14 \$635,000 appropriated for Grand Canyon airport water storage tank renovations
15 reverts to the state aviation fund and is transferred to the state general
16 fund on the effective date of this act.

17 F. Notwithstanding Laws 2005, chapter 298, section 4, the sum of
18 \$915,900 appropriated for a Payson motor vehicle division service center
19 reverts to the state highway fund on the effective date of this act.

20 G. Notwithstanding Laws 2007, chapter 267, section 12, the sum of
21 \$2,000,000 appropriated for state safety inspection station at San Luis II
22 port of entry reverts to the safety enforcement and transportation
23 infrastructure fund and is transferred to the state highway fund on the
24 effective date of this act.

25 H. Notwithstanding Laws 2008, chapter 289, section 4, the sum of
26 \$2,974,200 appropriated for the major maintenance and repair of department of
27 transportation state buildings reverts to the state highway fund on the
28 effective date of this act.

29 I. In addition to the amounts specified in Laws 2008, chapter 285,
30 section 25, notwithstanding any other law, \$34,468,000 received in fiscal
31 year 2008-2009 pursuant to title 28, chapter 16, article 3, Arizona Revised
32 Statutes, relating to vehicle license tax, for distribution to the state
33 highway fund pursuant to section 28-6538, subsection A, paragraph 1, Arizona
34 Revised Statutes, shall be deposited in the state general fund.
