AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1721, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE FAMILIES OF FALLEN POLICE OFFICERS SPECIAL PLATE FUND.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1721, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-1721. Families of fallen police officers special plate fund

5 The families of fallen police officers special plate fund is
6 established consisting of monies received pursuant to section 28-2427. The
7 department OF PUBLIC SAFETY shall administer the fund. The first thirty-two
8 thousand dollars received shall be reimbursed to the entity that paid the
9 implementation fee to the department OF TRANSPORTATION pursuant to section
10 28-2427, subsection A. Not more than ten per cent of monies deposited in the
11 fund annually shall be used for the cost of administering the fund. Monies
12 in the fund are continuously appropriated. The department OF PUBLIC SAFETY
13 shall allocate monies from the fund to ~~a~~ THE incorporated nonprofit
14 corporation in this state that PAID THE IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT
15 OF TRANSPORTATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-2427, SUBSECTION A AND is qualified
16 under section 501(c)(3) of the United States internal revenue code for
17 federal income tax purposes if the nonprofit corporation demonstrates a
18 commitment to helping in the healing of family survivors of police officers
19 who died in the line of duty in this state, PROVIDES TRAINING TO LAW
20 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES ON SURVIVOR VICTIMIZATION ISSUES AND EDUCATES THE PUBLIC
21 ABOUT THE NEED TO SUPPORT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT PROFESSION AND FAMILIES OF
22 FALLEN POLICE OFFICERS.
