AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 11-804, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COUNTY
PLANNING AND ZONING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 11-804, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 11-804. Organization of commission

5 A. The commission shall:

6 1. Elect a ~~chairman~~ CHAIRPERSON from among its members for a term of
7 one year, ~~and~~ such other officers as it may determine.

8 2. By resolution fix the time and place within the district of regular
9 meetings. ~~and~~

10 3. Hold at least one regular meeting each month, ~~and~~ WHEN THERE IS NEW
11 OFFICIAL BUSINESS TO TRANSACT and such additional meetings as the ~~chairman~~
12 CHAIRPERSON or a majority of the commission deems necessary.

13 ~~3.~~ 4. Adopt rules for the transaction of business, ~~and~~ keep a record
14 of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations, which record
15 shall be a public record and be open to public inspection.

16 ~~4.~~ 5. Transmit all of its recommendations, decisions, findings,
17 reports and official actions, regardless of vote, to the board of
18 supervisors.

19 B. A majority of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the
20 transaction of business and a majority vote of the quorum shall be required
21 for any official action.

22 Sec. 2. Suspension of action on county comprehensive plan

23 Notwithstanding section 11-824, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
24 a county board of supervisors is not required to readopt an existing
25 comprehensive plan or adopt a new comprehensive plan until July 1, 2015.

26 Sec. 3. Suspension of action on city or town general plan

27 Notwithstanding section 9-461.06, subsection K, Arizona Revised
28 Statutes, a city or town council is not required to readopt an existing
29 general plan or adopt a new general plan until July 1, 2015.
