CHAPTER 71

HOUSE BILL 2405

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 21.1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 36-2203; RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCIL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 21.1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2203, to read:

4 36-2203. Emergency medical services council; membership;
5 delayed repeal

6 A. THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCIL IS ESTABLISHED. THE MEDICAL
7 DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SHALL CHAIR THE COUNCIL. THE COUNCIL
8 IS COMPOSED OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE
9 GOVERNOR'S HIGHWAY SAFETY COORDINATOR, OR THEIR DESIGNEES, AND THE FOLLOWING
10 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO THREE YEAR TERMS:

11 1. ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH OF THE FOUR LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL
12 SERVICES COORDINATING SYSTEMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 36-2210.

13 2. ONE PHYSICIAN SPECIALIZING IN EMERGENCY MEDICINE FROM EACH OF THE
14 FOUR LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COORDINATING REGIONS AS PRESCRIBED IN
15 SECTION 36-2210.

16 3. ONE PROFESSIONAL NURSE WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32,
17 CHAPTER 15 AND WHO SPECIALIZES IN EMERGENCY MEDICINE.

18 4. ONE EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN.

19 5. TWO REPRESENTATIVES FROM AMBULANCE SERVICE CORPORATIONS.

20 6. TWO HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATORS, ONE OF WHOM REPRESENTS A COUNTY WITH A
21 POPULATION OF LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PERSONS.

22 7. ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH OF THE THREE EMPLOYERS OF THE LARGEST
23 NUMBER OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS AND PARAMEDICS.

24 8. ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A NONGOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYER OF INTERMEDIATE
25 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS.

26 9. ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE STATE FIRE DISTRICTS.

27 10. ONE PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO TITLE 32, CHAPTER 13 OR
28 17 AND WHO SPECIALIZES IN TRAUMA SURGERY.

29 11. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A PRE-HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRAINING
30 PROGRAM.

31 12. SIX PUBLIC MEMBERS.

32 13. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A VOLUNTEER MEDICAL RESCUE PROGRAM.

33 B. PUBLIC MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE COMPENSATION
34 PURSUANT TO SECTION 38-611.

35 C. THIS SECTION IS REPEALED FROM AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2020.

36 Sec. 2. Initial terms of members of the emergency medical
37 services council

38 A. Notwithstanding section 36-2203, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added
39 by this act, the initial terms of members of the emergency medical services
40 council are:

41 1. Nine terms ending January 1, 2012.

42 2. Nine terms ending January 1, 2013.

1 3. Ten terms ending January 1, 2014.
2 B. The governor shall make all subsequent appointments as prescribed
3 by statute.
4 Sec. 3. Emergency
5 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
6 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
7 law.
