CHAPTER 9

HOUSE BILL 2009

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE CONDITIONAL REPEAL OF SECTION 42-5031.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO BUDGET RECONCILIATION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Conditional repeal

3 If proposition 100 is not approved by the voters at the May 18, 2010
4 special election, section 42-5031.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

5 Sec. 2. Community colleges; capital outlay aid; suspension

6 Notwithstanding section 15-1464, Arizona Revised Statutes, or any other
7 law, capital outlay state aid for community colleges is suspended for fiscal
8 year 2010-2011.

9 Sec. 3. Community colleges; capital aid funding for fiscal year
10 2010-2011; uses

11 Notwithstanding section 15-1464, subsection G, Arizona Revised
12 Statutes, for fiscal year 2009-2010, each community college district may use
13 any portion of its capital outlay funding for operating aid expenses.

14 Sec. 4. Medical student loans; private schools; fiscal year
15 2010-2011; retroactivity

16 A. Notwithstanding section 15-1723, Arizona Revised Statutes, the
17 board of medical student loans is not required to apportion fifty per cent of
18 the monies in the medical student loan fund for students attending private
19 medical schools in fiscal year 2010-2011.

20 B. This section is effective retroactively to from and after June 30,
21 2010.

22 Sec. 5. Financial aid trust fund; required state match

23 Notwithstanding section 15-1642, subsection C, Arizona Revised
24 Statutes, for fiscal year 2010-2011, each dollar raised pursuant to the
25 surcharge on student registration assessed pursuant to section 15-1642,
26 subsection A, Arizona Revised Statutes, may be matched by less than two
27 dollars appropriated by the legislature.

28 Sec. 6. Community colleges; operating state aid

29 Notwithstanding section 15-1466, Arizona Revised Statutes, the fiscal
30 year 2010-2011 appropriation for operating state aid for community colleges
31 shall be the amount appropriated in the general appropriation act.

32 Sec. 7. Community colleges; equalization aid

33 Notwithstanding section 15-1468, Arizona Revised Statutes, the fiscal
34 year 2010-2011 appropriation for equalization aid for community colleges
35 shall be the amount appropriated in the general appropriation act.

36 Sec. 8. Conforming legislation

37 If section 42-5031.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed as
38 prescribed in this act, the legislative council staff shall prepare proposed
39 legislation conforming the Arizona Revised Statutes for consideration in the
40 fiftieth legislature, first regular session.
