SENATE BILL 1291

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 31-145, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO LABOR BY PRISONERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 31-145, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 31-145. Allowance for hard labor in reduction of fine

5 A. A prisoner sentenced to pay a fine shall be allowed not to exceed
6 ~~ten~~ FIFTY dollars per day credited to the fine for each day he is employed at
7 hard labor.

8 B. A person committed for nonpayment of a fine shall be given credit
9 toward payment for each day of imprisonment at the rate specified in the
10 commitment not to exceed ~~ten~~ FIFTY dollars per day.

11 C. A prisoner who refuses to perform hard labor for payment of a fine
12 is subject to the consequences for nonpayment of fines in section 13-810.
