HOUSE BILL 2406

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-824; AMENDING SECTION 13-1414, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ASSESSMENTS FOR CRIMES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 8, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding section 13-824, to read:

4 13-824. Assessments for dangerous crimes against children and
5 sexual assault

6 A. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER ASSESSMENT OR RESTITUTION, IF A PERSON IS
7 CONVICTED OF OR ADJUDICATED DELINQUENT FOR A DANGEROUS CRIME AGAINST CHILDREN
8 AS DEFINED IN SECTION 13-705 OR SEXUAL ASSAULT, THE COURT SHALL ORDER THE
9 PERSON TO PAY AN ASSESSMENT OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS. THE ASSESSMENT SHALL
10 NOT BE WAIVED AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO A SURCHARGE.

11 B. THE COURT SHALL TRANSMIT THE MONIES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS
12 SECTION TO THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE COST OF
13 INVESTIGATIONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 13-1414.

14 Sec. 2. Section 13-1414, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
15 13-1414. Expenses of investigation

16 Any medical OR FORENSIC INTERVIEW expenses arising out of the need to
17 secure evidence that a person has been the victim of a dangerous crime
18 against children as defined in section 13-705 or a sexual assault shall be
19 paid by the county in which the offense occurred.

20 Sec. 3. Effective date

21 Section 13-824, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act, is
22 effective from and after December 31, 2011.


