# HOUSE BILL 2192

AN ACT

REPEALING LAWS 2010, SIXTH SPECIAL SESSION, CHAPTER 2, SECTIONS 6 AND 7;  
RELATING TO THE STATE LOTTERY.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Laws 2010, sixth special session, chapter 2, sections 6 and 7 are  
4 repealed.

5 Sec. 2. State lottery; transfer

6 A. On July 1, 2012, the state lottery established pursuant to title 5,  
7 chapter 5.1, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, succeeds to the authority,  
8 powers, duties and responsibilities of the state lottery established pursuant  
9 to title 5, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes.

10 B. On July 1, 2012, the Arizona state lottery commission established  
11 pursuant to title 5, chapter 5.1, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
12 succeeds to the authority, powers, duties and responsibilities of the Arizona  
13 state lottery commission established pursuant to title 5, chapter 5, Arizona  
14 Revised Statutes.

15 C. This act does not alter the effect of any actions that were taken  
16 or impair the valid obligations of the state lottery or the Arizona state  
17 lottery commission established pursuant to title 5, chapter 5, Arizona  
18 Revised Statutes, in existence before July 1, 2012.

19 D. Administrative rules and orders that were adopted pursuant to title  
20 5, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, continue in effect until superseded  
21 by administrative action taken pursuant to title 5, chapter 5.1, article 2,  
22 Arizona Revised Statutes.

23 E. All administrative matters, contracts and judicial and  
24 quasi-judicial actions, whether completed, pending or in process, of the  
25 state lottery or the Arizona state lottery commission established pursuant to  
26 title 5, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, on July 1, 2012 are transferred  
27 to and retain the same status with the state lottery or the Arizona state  
28 lottery commission established pursuant to title 5, chapter 5.1, article 2,  
29 Arizona Revised Statutes.

30 F. All certificates, licenses, registrations, permits and other  
31 indicia of qualification and authority that were issued pursuant to title 5,  
32 chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, retain their validity for the duration  
33 of their terms of validity as provided by law.

34 G. All assets, including cash, inventory, equipment, records,  
35 furnishings and other property, all data and investigative findings and all  
36 appropriated monies that remain unexpended and unencumbered on July 1, 2012  
37 of the state lottery or the Arizona state lottery commission established  
38 pursuant to title 5, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, are transferred to  
39 the state lottery or the Arizona state lottery commission established  
40 pursuant to title 5, chapter 5.1, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes.

41 H. All personnel who are under the state personnel system and employed  
42 by the state lottery or the Arizona state lottery commission established  
43 pursuant to title 5, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, are transferred to  
44 comparable positions and pay classifications in the respective administrative  
45 units of the state lottery or the Arizona state lottery commission  
46 established pursuant to title 5, chapter 5.1, article 2, Arizona Revised  
47 Statutes, on July 1, 2012.


