AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 12, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 12-256; RELATING TO JUDICIAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 12, chapter 2, article 6, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 12-256, to read:

4 12-256. Probation officers; enforcement of pretrial release
5 conditions

6 IN COUNTIES WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN TWO MILLION PERSONS, AN
7 ADULT PROBATION OFFICER MAY SERVE WARRANTS, MAKE ARRESTS AND BRING PERSONS
8 WHO ARE SUBJECT TO THE SUPERVISION OF PRETRIAL SERVICES AND WHO ARE ALLEGED
9 TO HAVE VIOLATED A CONDITION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE BEFORE THE COURT. A
10 PROBATION OFFICER ENFORCING PRETRIAL RELEASE CONDITIONS HAS THE AUTHORITY OF
11 A PEACE OFFICER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE OFFICER'S DUTIES.
