HOUSE BILL 2422

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 42-17103, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL BUDGETING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 42-17103, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 42-17103. Publication of estimates of revenues and expenses and
5 notice of public hearing

6 A. The governing body of each county, city or town shall publish the
7 estimates of revenues and expenses, or a summary of the estimates of revenues
8 and expenses, and a notice of a public hearing of the governing body to hear
9 taxpayers and make tax levies at designated times and places. The summary
10 shall set forth the total estimated revenues and expenditures by fund type,
11 truth in taxation calculations and primary and secondary property tax levies
12 for all districts. A complete copy of the estimates of revenues and expenses
13 shall be made available at the city, town or county libraries and city, town
14 or county administrative offices and shall be posted IN A PROMINENT LOCATION
15 on the official websites, OR ON A WEBSITE OF AN ASSOCIATION OF CITIES AND
16 TOWNS FOR CITIES AND TOWNS THAT DO NOT HAVE OFFICIAL WEBSITES, NO LATER THAN
17 SEVEN BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE ESTIMATES OF REVENUES AND EXPENSES ARE
18 INITIALLY PRESENTED BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY. A COMPLETE COPY OF THE BUDGET
19 FINALLY ADOPTED UNDER SECTION 42-17105 SHALL BE POSTED IN A PROMINENT
20 LOCATION ON THE OFFICIAL WEBSITES NO LATER THAN SEVEN BUSINESS DAYS AFTER
21 FINAL ADOPTION.

22 B. BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012, BOTH THE ESTIMATES OF
23 REVENUES AND EXPENSES INITIALLY PRESENTED BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY AND THE
24 BUDGET FINALLY ADOPTED UNDER SECTION 42-17105 SHALL BE RETAINED AND
25 ACCESSIBLE IN A PROMINENT LOCATION ON THE OFFICIAL WEBSITES, OR ON A WEBSITE
26 OF AN ASSOCIATION OF CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CITIES AND TOWNS THAT DO NOT HAVE
27 OFFICIAL WEBSITES, FOR AT LEAST SIXTY MONTHS.

28 ~~B.~~ C. The summary of estimates and notice, together with the library
29 addresses and websites where the complete copy of estimates may be found,
30 shall be published once a week for at least two consecutive weeks after the
31 estimates are tentatively adopted in the official newspaper of the county,
32 city or town, if there is one, and, if not, in a newspaper of general
33 circulation in the county, city or town.

34 ~~C.~~ D. If a truth in taxation notice and hearing is required under
35 section 42-17107, the governing body may combine the notice under this
36 section with the truth in taxation notice.
