AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-511, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-511, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-511. Arizona state parks board; membership; appointment;
5 terms

6 A. There shall be an Arizona state parks board, which shall consist of
7 seven members. The state land commissioner shall be a member and the
8 remaining members, each of whom shall be a bona fide resident of the state,
9 shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to section 38-211. The
10 appointive members shall be selected because of their knowledge of and
11 interest in outdoor activities, multiple use of lands, archaeology, natural
12 resources and the value of the historical aspects of Arizona, and because of
13 their interest in the conservation of natural resources. Not less than ~~two~~
14 ONE of the appointive members shall be representative of the livestock
15 industry, ~~and~~ one appointive member shall be professionally engaged in
16 general recreation work AND ONE APPOINTIVE MEMBER SHALL BE PROFESSIONALLY
17 ENGAGED IN THE TOURISM INDUSTRY.

18 B. ~~Of the members first appointed, one shall serve for a term expiring~~
19 ~~the first Monday in January following the effective date of this article, and~~
20 ~~one each for terms expiring one, two, three, four and five years thereafter.~~
21 ~~Thereafter,~~ All appointments shall be for a full term of six years and shall
22 expire on the third Monday in January of the appropriate year.

23 Sec. 2. Retention of members

24 Notwithstanding section 41-511, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by
25 this act, all persons serving as members of the Arizona states park board on
26 the effective date of this act may continue to serve until the expiration of
27 their normal terms. The governor shall make all subsequent appointments as
28 prescribed by statute.






