CHAPTER 44

SENATE BILL 1154

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 3-108 AND 3-1084, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
COTTON RESEARCH AND PROTECTION COUNCIL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 3-108, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 3-108. Administrative support fund; use; exemption

5 A. A department of agriculture administrative support fund is
6 established. All monies collected pursuant to any interagency agreement with
7 the department pursuant to ~~section 3-554, subsection A,~~ section 3-588,
8 subsection A and section 3-1084, subsection A- C shall be deposited, pursuant
9 to sections 35-146 and 35-147, in the fund.

10 B. All monies collected pursuant to any interagency agreement with the
11 department in accordance with section 3-468.03, subsection A and section
12 3-526.03, subsection A shall be deposited in the fund or deposited in the
13 citrus, fruit and vegetable revolving fund established by section 3-447
14 pursuant to the terms of the interagency agreement. Deposits shall be made
15 pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147.

16 C. Monies in the fund are continuously appropriated and exempt from
17 the provisions of section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.

18 Sec. 2. Section 3-1084, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

19 3-1084. Council staff; administrative services; reimbursement

20 A. The council may employ staff, AT A RATE OF COMPENSATION DETERMINED
21 BY THE COUNCIL, to serve at the pleasure of the council, ~~and may~~ SHALL
22 prescribe the terms and conditions of employment of employees as necessary to
23 perform the functions prescribed by this article. ~~The council may provide,~~
24 ~~at a rate or amount determined by the council, compensation, vehicles and~~
25 ~~vehicle expenses, health care benefits, life insurance, retirement benefits~~
26 ~~and any other cost or expense associated with employment. Reimbursement for~~
27 ~~travel and subsistence expenses for council employees shall be in the amount~~
28 ~~prescribed by title 38, chapter 4, article 2. The council may employ state~~
29 ~~employees, who are subject to all terms and conditions of employment~~
30 ~~prescribed by the council, but who may elect to continue participation in~~
31 ~~retirement, life insurance and health care programs sponsored by this state.~~
32 ~~In the event of such an election, the council's contributions shall be~~
33 ~~identical to those established by this state.~~

34 B. All employees of the council are exempt from title 38, chapter 4,
35 articles ARTICLE 1 and 4 and chapter 5, article 2 and title 41, chapter 4,
36 articles 5 and 6 and are not under the jurisdiction of the department of
37 administration.

38 C. The council may also enter into an interagency agreement pursuant
39 ~~to title 11, chapter 7, article 3~~ with the department to provide necessary
40 administrative services to the council, including:

41 1. Providing secretarial and other services necessary for the council
42 to carry out its activities.

43 2. Establishing separate operating accounts for the council.

44 3. Providing necessary financial and accounting services to the
45 council, including the issuance of checks, payment of bills approved by the

- 1 council, annual audits, expenditure and receipt reports whether monthly or
2 annually, preparation of an annual budget and any other activities requested
3 by the council.
- 4 4. Receiving mail and other communications for the council.
- 5 5. Receiving monies authorized under this article for deposit,
6 pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147, in the appropriate funds.
- 7 6. Accepting donated monies on behalf of the council to be credited to
8 the account of the council.
- 9 7. Providing space for the meetings of the council.
- 10 8. Providing any other administrative services which the council
11 requests or finds necessary.
- 12 ~~B.~~ D. If the department performs any function under this article, it
13 acts as the agent of the council and has no authority or control over the
14 council or the council's employees or assets. The council shall reimburse
15 the department for any administrative services the department provides from
16 the monies received under this article in an amount agreed on by the council
17 and director. Monies received by the department shall be deposited, pursuant
18 to sections 35-146 and 35-147, in the administrative support fund established
19 by section 3-108.
