AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-108; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 7.1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-894; RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1, section
3 1, Constitution of Arizona, title 15, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised
4 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-108, to read:
5 15-108. Medical marijuana; school campuses; prohibition;
6 definition
7 A. IN ADDITION TO THE LIMITATIONS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 36-2802,
8 SUBSECTION B, A PERSON, INCLUDING A CARDHOLDER AS DEFINED IN SECTION 36-2801,
9 MAY NOT LAWFULLY POSSESS OR USE MARIJUANA ON THE CAMPUS OF ANY PUBLIC
10 UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE, COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR POST SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL
11 INSTITUTION.
12 B. A PERSON MAY NOT LAWFULLY POSSESS OR USE MARIJUANA ON THE CAMPUS OF
13 ANY HIGH SCHOOL, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, MIDDLE SCHOOL, COMMON SCHOOL OR
14 PRESCHOOL IN THIS STATE.
15 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 7.1, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
16 amended by adding section 36-894, to read:
17 36-894. Medical marijuana; child care facilities; prohibition
18 A PERSON, INCLUDING A CARDHOLDER AS DEFINED IN SECTION 36-2801, MAY NOT
19 LAWFULLY POSSESS OR USE MARIJUANA IN ANY CHILD CARE FACILITY IN THIS STATE.
20 Sec. 3. Severability
21 If a provision of this act or its application to any person or
22 circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions
23 or applications of the act that can be given effect without the invalid
24 provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are
25 severable.
26 Sec. 4. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote
27 Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,
28 sections 15-108, subsection A and 36-894, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added
29 by this act, are effective only on the affirmative vote of at least
30 three-fourths of the members of each house of the legislature.
