REPEALING SECTION 41-3012.11, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3022.11; RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Repeal  
3 Section 41-3012.11, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.  
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
5 amended by adding section 41-3022.11, to read:  
6 41-3022.11. Department of public safety; termination  
7 July 1, 2022  
8 A. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2022.  
9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 12 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2023.  
10 Sec. 3. Purpose  
11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
12 the legislature continues the department of public safety to prevent crime,  
13 apprehend violators, train law enforcement personnel and promote public  
14 safety.  
15 Sec. 4. Retroactivity  
16 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,  
17 2012.
