CHAPTER 40

HOUSE BILL 2283

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-671, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 38-671, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:
4 38-671. Employee benefits; exclusions; definitions
5 A. Any employee hired on or after the effective date of this section
6 is not eligible for state employee benefits until the employee has worked
7 regularly for at least ninety days.
8 B. Notwithstanding any other law, any state employee initially hired
9 on or after the effective date of this section is not eligible to become a
10 member of any state retirement system before the twenty-seventh week of
11 employment. The state employee shall become a member of the state retirement
12 system on the twenty-seventh week of employment if membership criteria is met
13 under the state retirement system statutes.
14 C. Subsection B of this section does not apply to a person who is
15 already a member of the state retirement system.
16 D. For the purposes of this section:
17 1. "State employee" means a person who is employed by an agency,
18 department, board or commission of this state, a university under the
19 jurisdiction of the Arizona board of regents, the judicial branch AND WHOSE
20 SALARY IS PAID THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, the Arizona
21 corporation commission or the legislature.
22 2. "State employee benefits" means any coverage provided pursuant to
23 article 4 of this chapter.
24 3. "State retirement system" means the Arizona state retirement system
25 established by chapter 5, article 2 of this title and the long-term
26 disability program established by chapter 5, article 2.1 of this title.




