CHAPTER 7

HOUSE BILL 2317

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 3.1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 41-1758.08; RELATING TO FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARDS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 12, article 3.1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 41-1758.08, to read:

4 41-1758.08. Fingerprint clearance card; use of expired card

5 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, AN EXPIRED FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE
6 CARD MAY BE USED TO SATISFY THE FINGERPRINT REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 15-183,
7 15-503, 15-512, 15-534, 15-782.02, 15-1330 OR 15-1881 IF THE PERSON SIGNS AN
8 AFFIDAVIT STATING BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

9 1. THE PERSON SUBMITTED A COMPLETED APPLICATION TO THE DIVISION FOR A
10 NEW FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARD WITHIN NINETY DAYS BEFORE THE EXPIRATION DATE
11 ON THE PERSON'S CURRENT FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARD.

12 2. THE PERSON IS NOT AWAITING TRIAL ON AND HAS NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF A
13 CRIMINAL OFFENSE THAT WOULD MAKE THE PERSON INELIGIBLE FOR A FINGERPRINT
14 CLEARANCE CARD.

15 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARD THAT
16 HAS BEEN DENIED, SUSPENDED OR REVOKED OR TO A PERSON WHO HAS REQUESTED A GOOD
17 CAUSE EXCEPTION HEARING.

18 Sec. 2. Emergency

19 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
20 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
21 law.
