HOUSE BILL 2430

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 36-673, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 36-673, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 36-673. Duties of local health departments; immunization;
5 reimbursement; training; informed consent

6 A. A local health department in cooperation with each school within
7 the county shall provide for the required immunization of pupils attending
8 school.

9 B. A local health department shall provide immunizations required for
10 school attendance at no cost to the pupil or pupil's parent, guardian or
11 person in loco parentis. IN ORDER TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST OF
12 THE IMMUNIZATION FROM THE PUPIL'S OR PARENT'S PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE
13 COVERAGE, THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT GOVERNING THE
14 TERMS OF REIMBURSEMENT AND CLAIMS, WITH THE CORRESPONDING PRIVATE HEALTH CARE
15 INSURER. THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A
16 PRIVATE HEALTH CARE INSURER ON ITS OWN, IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER LOCAL
17 HEALTH DEPARTMENTS OR THROUGH A QUALIFIED INTERMEDIARY. IF THE LOCAL HEALTH
18 DEPARTMENT CHOOSES NOT TO CONTRACT WITH A PRIVATE HEALTH CARE INSURER OR DOES
19 NOT RESPOND TO THE REQUEST TO CONTRACT FROM A PRIVATE HEALTH CARE INSURER
20 WITHIN NINETY DAYS OF THE REQUEST, THE INSURER IS NOT REQUIRED TO REIMBURSE
21 THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMMUNIZATION. IF A PRIVATE HEALTH CARE
22 INSURER DECLINES OR DOES NOT RESPOND TO A REQUEST TO CONTRACT WITH A LOCAL
23 HEALTH DEPARTMENT, WITH A COALITION OF OTHER LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS OR
24 THROUGH A QUALIFIED INTERMEDIARY WITHIN NINETY DAYS OF THE REQUEST TO
25 CONTRACT, THE PRIVATE HEALTH CARE INSURER MUST REIMBURSE THE LOCAL HEALTH
26 DEPARTMENT AT THE RATE PAID TO AN IN-NETWORK PROVIDER.

27 C. A local health department, on request by a school nurse and
28 approval by the school administrator, shall train and authorize the school
29 nurse to administer required immunizations.

30 D. A ~~minor-child~~ PUPIL shall not be immunized without the informed
31 consent of the parent, guardian or person in loco parentis of the ~~child~~
32 PUPIL. A pupil who is at least eighteen years of age or is emancipated may
33 consent to immunization.




