SENATE BILL 1310

AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Industrial commission; insolvent insurer report

3 The industrial commission shall publish a report showing the amount of
4 cash and assets held by the special fund established by section 23-1065,
5 Arizona Revised Statutes, that are attributable or allocated to the payment
6 of claims of insolvent insurers as defined in section 20-661, paragraph 5,
7 Arizona Revised Statutes, as of June 30, 2013. The report shall include all
8 insurance carriers that have had claims assigned to the special fund pursuant
9 to section 23-966, subsection A, Arizona Revised Statutes. The report shall
10 be accompanied by a statement of actuarial opinion by an actuary who is a
11 member in good standing of the American academy of actuaries confirming the
12 adequacy of the reserves reported. The amount of attributed cash and assets
13 shall include the total amount of monies that are held by the special fund
14 from any assessments, recoveries and released deposits. The commission shall
15 publish the report at the last industrial commission meeting in 2013 and
16 shall include an explanation of the methodology and all of the data relied on
17 to produce the statement. The report shall include an opinion from an
18 independent certified public accountant on whether the methodology employed
19 fairly presents the attribution of cash and assets to the payment of claims
20 of insolvent insurers as defined in section 20-661, Arizona Revised Statutes.

21 Sec. 2. Applicability

22 Laws 2013, chapter 34 applies to any claim that has not been accepted
23 as compensable or adjudicated as compensable as of the effective date of Laws
24 2013, chapter 34.


