CHAPTER 223

HOUSE BILL 2265

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-1464, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-1464, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-1464. State aid per capita distribution for science,
5 technology, engineering and mathematics; science,
6 technology, engineering and mathematics fund;
7 appropriation; report

8 A. In addition to the appropriation prescribed in section 15-1463,
9 subsection A, this state shall pay to each community college district state
10 aid for ~~capital outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND
11 WORKFORCE PROGRAMS in the following manner:

12 1. For fiscal year 1992-1993 for a community college district which
13 had less than five thousand actual full-time equivalent students according to
14 the most recent fiscal year actual full-time equivalent student count, the
15 amount determined by multiplying the number of actual full-time equivalent
16 students according to the most recent fiscal year actual full-time equivalent
17 student count by two hundred seven dollars.

18 2. For fiscal year 1992-1993 for a community college district which
19 had five thousand or more actual full-time equivalent students according to
20 the most recent fiscal year actual full-time equivalent student count, the
21 amount determined by multiplying the number of actual full-time equivalent
22 students according to the most recent fiscal year actual full-time equivalent
23 student count by one hundred fifty-eight dollars.

24 3. Beginning with fiscal year 1993-1994 the legislature shall adjust
25 by the growth rate for common and high school districts as provided by law,
26 subject to appropriation, the amount of state aid to community college
27 districts as provided in paragraphs 1 and 2 OF THIS SUBSECTION.

28 B. The basis for computing full-time equivalent students for the
29 ~~capital outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE
30 PROGRAMS per capita distribution shall be on the same basis as the
31 computation prescribed in section 15-1466.01.

32 C. In addition to the formula to determine the appropriations
33 prescribed in section 15-1463, subsection A and subsection A of this section,
34 this state may pay additional amounts for ~~capital outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,
35 ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS to a community college
36 district based on requests from the district.

37 D. Appropriations for ~~capital outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING
38 AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS made pursuant to subsections A and C
39 of this section and section 15-1463 shall be made to an account designated as
40 the ~~capital outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND
41 WORKFORCE PROGRAMS fund. MONIES IN THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR SCIENCE,
42 TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS PURPOSES, AND
43 THE EXPENDITURES MAY INCLUDE:

44 1. PARTNERSHIPS WITH BUSINESSES AND EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

1 2. ADDITIONAL FACULTY FOR IMPROVED AND EXPANDED CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION
2 AND COURSE OFFERINGS.

3 3. TECHNOLOGY, EQUIPMENT AND TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE FOR ADVANCED
4 TEACHING AND LEARNING IN CLASSROOMS OR LABORATORIES.

5 4. STUDENT SERVICES SUCH AS ASSESSMENT, ADVISEMENT AND COUNSELING FOR
6 NEW AND EXPANDED JOB OPPORTUNITIES.

7 5. THE PURCHASE, LEASE OR LEASE-PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY, FOR NEW
8 CONSTRUCTION, REMODELING OR REPAIR OF BUILDINGS OR FACILITIES ON REAL
9 PROPERTY.

10 E. At the beginning of each fiscal year, the district board shall
11 present to the department of administration a claim for the annual amount
12 appropriated by the legislature and assigned to the district for ~~capital~~
13 ~~outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE
14 PROGRAMS purposes. The department of administration shall draw a warrant in
15 payment of the claim and shall transmit the warrant to the state treasurer
16 who shall disburse the funds to the district for ~~capital-outlay~~ SCIENCE,
17 TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS purposes, to
18 be expended as provided by law. If no community college exists, the
19 department shall establish a fund for new future community college districts
20 to be disbursed as needed.

21 F. Notwithstanding subsection E of this section, a community college
22 district may request the state treasurer to disburse the monies to the local
23 government investment pool for deposit into the district's account as
24 established in section 35-326.

25 G. Each district has the option of using up to twenty per cent of its
26 total ~~capital-outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND
27 WORKFORCE PROGRAMS aid appropriation for operating aid purposes or taking
28 this same amount out of the district's total operating state aid
29 appropriation and using it for ~~capital-outlay~~ SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,
30 ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS purposes.

31 H. ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EVERY EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR, EACH COMMUNITY
32 COLLEGE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT OF ITS SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,
33 ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS PLAN ACTIVITIES AND THE
34 EXPENDITURES AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION TO THE GOVERNOR, PRESIDENT OF THE
35 SENATE, SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET
36 COMMITTEE AND ARIZONA COMMERCE AUTHORITY. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE
37 PURPOSE AND GOALS FOR WHICH THE SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND
38 MATHEMATICS AND WORKFORCE PROGRAMS MONIES WERE EXPENDED BY EACH DISTRICT WITH
39 A GENERAL ACCOUNTING OF THE EXPENDITURES. EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT
40 SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
