HOUSE BILL 2004

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-3013.06, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3023.06; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; MAKING A TRANSFER; RELATING TO ENVIRONMENT BUDGET RECONCILIATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 41-3013.06, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3023.06, to read:

6 41-3023.06. Arizona state parks board; termination July 1, 2023

7 A. THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2023.

8 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1.1 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2024.

9 Sec. 3. Arizona water protection fund; use; fiscal year

10 2013-2014

11 Notwithstanding section 45-2114, Arizona Revised Statutes, in fiscal
12 year 2013-2014, the Arizona water protection fund commission may grant to the
13 department of water resources up to \$336,000 of the unobligated balance in
14 the Arizona water protection fund established by section 45-2111, Arizona
15 Revised Statutes, to pay for administrative costs of the department in fiscal
16 year 2013-2014.

17 Sec. 4. Off-highway vehicle recreation fund; use

18 Notwithstanding section 28-1176, Arizona Revised Statutes, the Arizona
19 state parks board may spend up to \$692,100 from the Arizona state parks board
20 portion of the off-highway vehicle recreation fund in fiscal year 2013-2014
21 for parks board operating expenses.

22 Sec. 5. Underground storage tank assurance account; transfer of
23 monies; uses

24 Notwithstanding any other law, the administrative cap established in
25 section 49-1051, subsection B, paragraphs 2 and 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,
26 is suspended for fiscal year 2013-2014, and the department of environmental
27 quality may transfer a combined total of \$6,531,000 from the assurance
28 account of the underground storage tank revolving fund and the regulated
29 substance fund established by section 49-1015.01, Arizona Revised Statutes,
30 for administrative costs of the department.

31 Sec. 6. Water resources fees; intent; exemption from rule
32 making

33 A. Notwithstanding any other law, the director of the department of
34 water resources may increase fees in fiscal year 2013-2014 for services in
35 fiscal year 2013-2014.

36 B. Monies received from any fees collected pursuant to subsection A of
37 this section shall be deposited in the water resources fund established by
38 section 45-117, Arizona Revised Statutes.

39 C. It is the intent of the legislature that the revenue generated by
40 the fees collected pursuant to subsection A of this section shall not exceed
41 \$100,200.

42 D. The department of water resources is exempt from the rule making
43 requirements of title 41, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, for the
44 purpose of establishing fees pursuant to this section until July 1, 2014.
