CHAPTER 4

SENATE BILL 1224

AN ACT

MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY FOR
CHILD SAFETY AND FAMILY SERVICES POSITIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Supplemental appropriations; department of economic
3 security; child safety and family services
4 positions; reports

5 A. In addition to any other monies appropriated to the department of
6 economic security in fiscal year 2013-2014, the sum of \$5,748,000 from the
7 state general fund, the sum of \$1,111,300 from total expenditure authority
8 and 192 FTE positions are appropriated in fiscal year 2013-2014 to the
9 department of economic security for child safety and family services
10 positions.

11 B. Beginning on the seventh day of the month following the effective
12 date of this act and on the seventh day of each month thereafter through June
13 30, 2015, the department of economic security or its successor agency shall
14 issue to the governor, the chairpersons of the house of representatives
15 appropriations and reform and human services committees and the senate
16 appropriations and health and human services committees and the staff
17 directors of the joint legislative budget committee and the governor's office
18 of strategic planning and budgeting a report on the department's progress in
19 hiring child safety and family services staff. The report shall include the
20 total number of child safety and family services FTE positions funded and the
21 total number of child safety and family services FTE positions filled on
22 January 31, 2014 and on the last day of each month thereafter. The
23 department shall delineate the increase in staff by caseworkers, hotline
24 staff, staff in training and non-caseworkers.
