## **SENATE BILL 1039**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-901, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE STATE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-901, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 32-901. Board of chiropractic examiners; removal; immunity

5 A. ~~There shall be a~~ THE state board of chiropractic examiners IS  
6 ESTABLISHED consisting of three licensed chiropractors and two consumer  
7 members WHO ARE appointed by the governor. One member shall be appointed  
8 each year for a term of five years, to begin and end on July 1.

9 B. Each member of the board shall be a resident of this state, and  
10 each of the licensed chiropractic members shall have practiced chiropractic  
11 in this state for ~~not less than~~ three years OR MORE. ~~No two chiropractic~~  
12 ~~members of the board shall be graduates of the same school or college of~~  
13 ~~chiropractic.~~ The two consumer members of the board shall not be in any  
14 manner connected with, or have an interest in, any college or school of  
15 chiropractic or any person practicing any form of healing or treatment of  
16 bodily or mental ailments. A board member shall not receive compensation as  
17 an agent or employee of or a contractor for an insurance company. This  
18 subsection does not prevent a board member who is a licensed chiropractor  
19 from receiving compensation from an insurance company for patient care as  
20 provided for in a patient's insurance policy.

21 C. ~~Board members, prior to entering upon their duties,~~ BEFORE TAKING  
22 OFFICE, EACH BOARD MEMBER shall take an oath prescribed by law and ~~in~~  
23 ~~addition shall make an oath as to their~~ AFFIRM BY OATH THAT THE BOARD MEMBER  
24 MEETS THE qualifications as prescribed in this section.

25 D. Board members may be removed by the governor for neglect of duty,  
26 malfeasance or misfeasance in office. Vacancies occurring on the board other  
27 than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the  
28 term by appointment in the same manner as regular appointments.

29 E. No member of the board may serve more than two consecutive terms.

30 F. A board member who acts within ~~his~~ THE BOARD MEMBER'S authority is  
31 personally immune from civil liability with respect to all actions ~~he takes~~  
32 TAKEN in good faith pursuant to this chapter.
