## **HOUSE BILL 2404**

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 51; RELATING TO THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER AUTHORIZATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding  
3 chapter 51, to read:

4 CHAPTER 51

5 THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER AUTHORIZATION

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 41-5101. State agencies; third-party electronic service  
8 provider authorization; definitions

9 A. ANY STATE AGENCY MAY AUTHORIZE A PERSON TO BE A THIRD-PARTY  
10 ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER.

11 B. THE WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE AGENCY AND THE AUTHORIZED  
12 THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER MAY BE FOR A LIMITED NUMBER OF  
13 SERVICES AND MAY LIMIT THE PERSONS THAT MAY RECEIVE THE SERVICES.

14 C. AN AUTHORIZED THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER MUST MEET ALL  
15 OF THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE AGENCY AND MUST BE SELECTED  
16 THROUGH A COMPETITIVE BID PROCESS.

17 D. AN AUTHORIZED THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER:

18 1. SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE AGENCY ALL STATUTORILY PRESCRIBED FEES  
19 AND TAXES IT COLLECTS AND DEPOSIT THE FEES AND TAXES WITH THE STATE TREASURER  
20 PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 35-147.

21 2. MAY COLLECT AND RETAIN A REASONABLE AND COMMENSURATE FEE FOR ITS  
22 SERVICES.

23 E. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

24 1. "AUTHORIZED THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS AN  
25 ENTITY THAT HAS EXECUTED A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH A STATE AGENCY AND THAT IS  
26 AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE AGENCY TO PROVIDE ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION SERVICES  
27 BETWEEN THE STATE AGENCY, PRIVATE CITIZENS, OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND  
28 PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ENTITIES IN THIS STATE OR IN ANY OTHER STATE, TERRITORY OR  
29 COUNTRY.

30 2. "PERSON" INCLUDES A CORPORATION, COMPANY, PARTNERSHIP, FIRM,  
31 ASSOCIATION OR SOCIETY.

32 3. "STATE AGENCY" HAS THE SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 41-3101.


