HOUSE BILL 2654

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-4602, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO GOVERNMENTAL REPORTING OF INFORMATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-4602, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-4602. Comprehensive internet web portal of local governments

5 The department of administration shall establish an internet web portal
6 that provides a list of all local governments with jurisdiction over any
7 address entered by a user. Each listing shall be linked to an agency website
8 maintained by each local government that shall primarily contain the
9 following information:

10 1. The name of the local government's governing board with official
11 contact information for each board member, including a phone number for
12 direct contact by constituents.

13 2. The name and contact information for the administrative head of the
14 local government.

15 3. Information for how the governing board and administrative head of
16 the local government are selected, including dates of the next election, if
17 any, durations of terms and names and contact information of appointing
18 authorities, as applicable.

19 4. Information on taxes or fees controlled by the local government,
20 INCLUDING THE TOTAL TAXES PER CAPITA OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE
21 POPULATION WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION ALONG WITH A STATEWIDE AVERAGE OF ALL
22 SIMILAR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AS CALCULATED BY THE DEPARTMENT, and proposed
23 changes in the taxes or fees.

24 5. Information on special elections, which shall be posted at least
25 ninety days in advance of the election date.

26 6. A link to the official internet website required by section 41-725.

27 7. THE TOTAL VALUE OF ALL OUTSTANDING DEBT OBLIGATIONS, INCLUDING THE
28 ACTUARIAL VALUE OF UNFUNDED PENSION LIABILITIES AND THE EQUIVALENT AMOUNT ON
29 A PER CAPITA BASIS FOR THE POPULATION WITHIN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT'S
30 JURISDICTION.






