SENATE BILL 1051

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-1428, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA
MEDICAL BOARD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-1428, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-1428. Pro bono registration

5 A. The board may issue a pro bono registration to allow a doctor who
6 is not a licensee to practice in this state for a total of up to sixty days
7 each calendar year if the doctor:

8 1. Holds an active and unrestricted license to practice medicine in a
9 state, territory or possession of the United States or an inactive license
10 pursuant to section 32-1431.

11 2. Has never had the license revoked or suspended.

12 3. Is not the subject of an unresolved complaint.

13 4. Applies for registration on a yearly basis as prescribed by the
14 board.

15 ~~5. Provides proof satisfactory to the board that the doctor meets the
16 applicable requirements of section 32-1422, 32-1423 or 32-1424.~~

17 ~~6.~~ 5. Agrees to render all medical services without accepting a fee
18 or salary or performs only initial or follow-up examinations at no cost to
19 the patient and the patient's family through a charitable organization.

20 B. The sixty days of practice prescribed pursuant to subsection A of
21 this section may be performed consecutively or cumulatively during each
22 calendar year.

23 C. FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS
24 SECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE THE BOARD THE NAME OF EACH STATE IN WHICH
25 THE PERSON IS LICENSED OR HAS HELD A LICENSE AND THE BOARD SHALL VERIFY WITH
26 THE APPLICABLE REGULATORY BOARD OF EACH STATE THAT THE APPLICANT IS LICENSED
27 OR HAS HELD A LICENSE, HAS NEVER HAD A LICENSE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED AND IS
28 NOT THE SUBJECT OF AN UNRESOLVED COMPLAINT. THE BOARD MAY ACCEPT THE
29 VERIFICATION OF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPHS 1, 2 AND
30 3 OF THIS SECTION FROM EACH OF THE OTHER STATE'S REGULATORY BOARD EITHER
31 ELECTRONICALLY OR BY HARD COPY.

32 Sec. 2. Retroactivity

33 Section 32-1428, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act,
34 applies retroactively to from and after December 31, 2012 to applications
35 submitted to the Arizona medical board for calendar year 2014.

36 Sec. 3. Emergency

37 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
38 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
39 law.
