# **SENATE BILL 1401**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A SUBMARINE MEMORIAL IN WESLEY BOLIN PLAZA.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. United States submarine memorial; procedures;  
3 delayed repeal

4 A. Pursuant to section 41-1363, subsection A, Arizona Revised  
5 Statutes, this act authorizes the department of administration to provide for  
6 the placement in Wesley Bolin plaza of a memorial dedicated to the  
7 commemoration of United States submarine veterans.

8 B. The procedures prescribed in section 41-1363, subsection B, Arizona  
9 Revised Statutes, apply to the establishment of the monument.

10 C. Public monies are not authorized for the costs of the monument.  
11 All fund-raising and contracts for artistic design and construction of the  
12 memorial are the sole responsibility of the proponents. This state shall not  
13 facilitate fund-raising or establish a state fund for the deposit of the  
14 monies.

15 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2017.


