SENATE BILL 1091

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 32-3104 AND 32-4402, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-3104, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-3104. Applicant groups; written report

5 Applicant groups shall submit a written report explaining the factors
6 prescribed in section 32-3105 or 32-3106 to the ~~joint legislative audit~~
7 ~~committee established pursuant to section 41-1279~~ PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND
8 THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. The report shall be submitted
9 on or before September 1 ~~prior to~~ BEFORE the start of the legislative session
10 for which the legislation is proposed. The ~~joint legislative audit committee~~
11 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES shall
12 assign the written report to the appropriate legislative committee of
13 reference. The legislative committee of reference shall study the written
14 report and deliver the report of its recommendations to the ~~joint legislative~~
15 ~~audit committee~~, the speaker of the house of representatives, the president
16 of the senate, the governor and, if appropriate, the regulatory board of the
17 health profession on or before December 1 of the year in which the report is
18 submitted. Legislative committees of reference may hold hearings as they
19 deem necessary. If a health professional group proposes to increase the
20 scope of practice of its profession, copies of the written report shall be
21 sent to the regulatory board of the health profession for review and comment.
22 If applicable, the regulatory board of the health profession shall make
23 recommendations based on the report submitted by applicant groups to the
24 extent requested by the legislative committees of reference.

28 Applicant groups shall submit a written report explaining the factors

30 ~~established pursuant to section 41-1279~~ THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE
31 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. The report shall be submitted on or
32 before September 1 ~~prior to~~ BEFORE the start of the legislative session for
33 which the legislation is proposed. The ~~joint legislative audit committee~~
34 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES shall
35 assign the written report to the appropriate legislative committee of
36 reference. The legislative committee of reference shall study the written
