SENATE BILL 1476

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 26, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 26-305.03; RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 26, chapter 2, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 26-305.03, to read:

4 26-305.03. Electromagnetic pulse preparedness recommendations;
5 posting; definition

6 A. THE DIVISION SHALL DEVELOP PREPAREDNESS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE
7 PUBLIC REGARDING THE TYPE AND QUANTITY OF SUPPLIES, INCLUDING FOOD, WATER AND
8 MEDICAL SUPPLIES, THAT EACH PERSON IN THIS STATE SHOULD POSSESS IN
9 PREPARATION FOR AN ELECTROMAGNETIC PULSE THAT MIGHT OCCUR OVER THE UNITED
10 STATES. THE DIVISION SHALL POST THE PREPAREDNESS RECOMMENDATIONS ON ITS
11 WEBSITE AND SHALL UPDATE THE PREPAREDNESS RECOMMENDATIONS AT LEAST EVERY FIVE
12 YEARS.

13 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ELECTROMAGNETIC PULSE" MEANS A
14 BURST OF ELECTROMAGNETIC ENERGY OCCURRING IN THE FORM OF A RADIATED ELECTRIC
15 MAGNETIC FIELD OR CONDUCTED ELECTRICAL CURRENT CAUSED BY A CORONAL MASS
16 EJECTION FROM THE SUN, DETONATION OF A NUCLEAR BOMB HIGH IN EARTH'S UPPER
17 ATMOSPHERE OR A MAN-MADE ELECTROMECHANICAL DEVICE.
