# **HOUSE BILL 2591**

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 11-955; RELATING TO THE JOINT EXERCISE OF GOVERNMENTAL POWERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 11, chapter 7, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 11-955, to read:

4 11-955. Joint powers public safety committee; powers and duties

5 A. THE CHIEF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR THE OFFICER'S DESIGNEE FROM  
6 TWO OR MORE CITIES, TOWNS, INDIAN TRIBES OR COUNTIES IN THIS STATE MAY  
7 ESTABLISH A JOINT POWERS PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
8 FACILITATING THE SHARING OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION BETWEEN LAW  
9 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 41-1750. THE CHIEF LAW  
10 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR THE OFFICER'S DESIGNEE FROM EACH CITY, TOWN, COUNTY OR  
11 INDIAN TRIBE SHALL ESTABLISH A GOVERNING BOARD.

12 B. THE GOVERNING BOARD SHALL:

13 1. ESTABLISH RULES RELATED TO THE GOVERNANCE OF THE COMMITTEE.

14 2. ESTABLISH RULES RELATED TO THE SECURITY, PRIVACY, CONFIDENTIALITY  
15 AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY THE COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO  
16 STATE AND FEDERAL LAW.

17 3. ELECT A BUDGET OFFICER FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS TO FULFILL ANY  
18 ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMITTEE.

19 4. ANNUALLY ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR.

20 C. THE COMMITTEE MAY ACCEPT AND SPEND PUBLIC MONIES AND PRIVATE  
21 GRANTS, GIFTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS.

22 D. MEMBERSHIP ON THE COMMITTEE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE THE HOLDING OF AN  
23 OFFICE, AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TAKE AND FILE OATHS OF  
24 OFFICE BEFORE SERVING ON THE COMMITTEE. NO COMMITTEE MEMBER MAY BE  
25 DISQUALIFIED FROM HOLDING ANY PUBLIC OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT NOR MAY THE MEMBER  
26 FORFEIT ANY OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT BY REASON OF THE MEMBER'S APPOINTMENT,  
27 NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISION OF ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE  
28 OR CITY CHARTER.






