# **SENATE BILL 1001**

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND AND MAKING  
NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND ASSESSMENTS.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; nuclear emergency management fund

3 Pursuant to sections 26-306.01 and 26-306.02, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
4 the sum of \$2,404,010 in fiscal year 2015-2016 and the sum of \$2,412,474 in  
5 fiscal year 2016-2017 are appropriated from the state general fund to the  
6 nuclear emergency management fund for the following agencies:

7 1. For use by the division of emergency management of the department  
8 of emergency and military affairs as provided in section 26-306.02, Arizona  
9 Revised Statutes, the lump sum of \$633,196 and 5.5 full-time equivalent  
10 positions in fiscal year 2015-2016 and \$647,746 and 5.5 full-time equivalent  
11 positions in fiscal year 2016-2017.

12 2. For use by the Arizona department of agriculture for programs  
13 relating to off-site nuclear emergency response plans, the lump sum of  
14 \$198,434 and 1.88 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2015-2016 and  
15 \$198,434 and 1.88 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2016-2017.

16 3. For use by the radiation regulatory agency for programs relating to  
17 off-site nuclear emergency response plans, the lump sum of \$819,663 and 5.5  
18 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2015-2016 and \$789,663 and 5.5  
19 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2016-2017.

20 4. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the  
21 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of  
22 Maricopa county that are assigned responsibilities under the off-site nuclear  
23 emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$682,808 in fiscal year 2015-2016  
24 and \$706,722 in fiscal year 2016-2017.

25 5. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the  
26 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of  
27 the town of Buckeye that are assigned responsibilities under the off-site  
28 nuclear emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$69,909 in fiscal year  
29 2015-2016 and \$69,909 in fiscal year 2016-2017.

30 Sec. 2. Assessments; purpose

31 Pursuant to section 26-306.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, the sum of  
32 \$2,404,010 in fiscal year 2015-2016 and \$2,412,474 in fiscal year 2016-2017,  
33 plus any applicable interest, is assessed against each consortium of public  
34 service corporations and municipal corporations engaged in constructing or  
35 operating a commercial nuclear generating station in this state.

36 Sec. 3. Emergency

37 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
38 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
39 law.
