HOUSE BILL 2346

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 36-2814, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA
MEDICAL MARIJUANA ACT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,
3 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2814, Arizona Revised
4 Statutes, is amended to read:

5 36-2814. Acts not required; acts not prohibited

6 A. Nothing in this chapter requires:

7 1. A government medical assistance program, ~~or~~ A private health
8 insurer OR A WORKERS' COMPENSATION CARRIER OR SELF-INSURED EMPLOYER PROVIDING
9 WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS to reimburse a person for costs associated
10 with the medical use of marijuana.

11 2. Any person or establishment in lawful possession of property to
12 allow a guest, client, customer or other visitor to use marijuana on or in
13 that property.

14 3. An employer to allow the ingestion of marijuana in any workplace or
15 any employee to work while under the influence of marijuana, except that a
16 registered qualifying patient shall not be considered to be under the
17 influence of marijuana solely because of the presence of metabolites or
18 components of marijuana that appear in insufficient concentration to cause
19 impairment.

20 B. Nothing in this chapter prohibits an employer from disciplining an
21 employee for ingesting marijuana in the workplace or working while under the
22 influence of marijuana.

23 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote

24 Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,
25 section 36-2814, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, is
26 effective only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the
27 members of each house of the legislature.
