HOUSE BILL 2347

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 23-772, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 23-772, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 23-772. Claims for benefits; initial claim filing notice to
5 employer; contents of notice; continued claim notice
6 to employer; posting printed statements dealing with
7 claims

8 A. Claims for benefits shall be made in accordance with such
9 regulations as the department prescribes. The department shall require an
10 individual claiming benefits to provide information and documents on which
11 the claim is based at the time of filing the claim.

12 B. WHEN AN INITIAL CLAIM FOR BENEFITS IS FILED, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
13 PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE CLAIMANT'S MOST RECENT EMPLOYING UNIT OR EMPLOYER OF THE
14 CLAIM FILING. THE NOTICE SHALL:

15 1. CONTAIN THE CLAIMANT'S STATED REASON FOR THE CLAIMANT'S SEPARATION
16 FROM EMPLOYMENT.

17 2. STATE THAT THE EMPLOYER MAY PROTEST PAYMENT TO THE CLAIMANT BASED
18 ON ANY AVAILABLE STATUTORY GROUNDS BY RETURNING THE PROTEST NOT LATER THAN
19 TEN BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE NOTICE.

20 ~~B.~~ C. UNLESS PREVIOUSLY NOTIFIED, all base-period employers ~~of a~~
21 ~~claimant for benefits shall be promptly notified when a~~ WILL BE SENT A NOTICE
22 AT THE TIME THE claimant files a payable continued claim for benefits during
23 a period of unemployment.

24 ~~C.~~ D. Each employer shall post and maintain printed statements
25 dealing with claims for benefits in places readily accessible to individuals
26 in the employer's service, and shall make available to each individual at the
27 time the individual becomes unemployed a printed statement dealing with
28 claims for benefits. Printed statements shall be supplied by the department
29 to each employer without cost.
