# **HOUSE BILL 2569**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY SUBMIT CORRECTIONS  
TO TEACHER EXPERIENCE INDEX DATA.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. School districts; teacher experience index;  
3 submission of corrected data

4 A. Notwithstanding sections 15-905 and 15-915 and section 15-941,  
5 subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes, a school district for which the  
6 fiscal year 2014-2015 teacher experience index is less than or equal to  
7 1.0000 may submit corrections to teacher experience index data that are  
8 required pursuant to section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, if all of the  
9 following conditions exist:

10 1. The school district's average daily membership for the 2013-2014  
11 school year was less than one hundred fifty but more than one hundred  
12 thirty-five.

13 2. The school district is a common school district.

14 3. The teacher experience index for the school district pursuant to  
15 section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, for fiscal year 2013-2014 was  
16 greater than 1.1000 and the current teacher experience index for the school  
17 district for fiscal year 2014-2015 is less than or equal to 1.0000.

18 4. The school district received basic state aid in fiscal year  
19 2013-2014 and is receiving basic state aid for fiscal year 2014-2015.

20 5. The school district has completed the submission of teacher  
21 experience index data required to be submitted on or before October 15, 2014  
22 under section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, and the resulting preliminary  
23 teacher experience index as prescribed in section 15-941, subsection C,  
24 Arizona Revised Statutes, is greater than 1.0000.

25 B. If all the conditions prescribed in subsection A of this section  
26 are met, the school district may submit corrections to teacher experience  
27 index data, no later than August 15, 2015, that are required pursuant to  
28 section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, and the school district may use the  
29 resulting teacher experience index in the determination of its base support  
30 level for fiscal year 2014-2015.

31 C. Notwithstanding sections 15-905 and 15-915 and section 15-941,  
32 subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes, a school district for which the  
33 fiscal year 2015-2016 teacher experience index is less than or equal to  
34 1.0040 may submit corrections to teacher experience index data that are  
35 required pursuant to section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, if all of the  
36 following conditions exist:

37 1. The school district's average daily membership, excluding average  
38 daily membership for district sponsored charter schools, for the 2014-2015  
39 school year is less than one thousand six hundred but more than one thousand  
40 five hundred twenty-five.

41 2. The school district is a common school district.

42 3. The teacher experience index calculated for the school district  
43 pursuant to section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, for fiscal year  
44 2014-2015 is greater than 1.0280, but less than 1.0300.

1           4. The teacher experience index for the school district calculated as  
2 of March 15, 2015, for fiscal year 2015-2016 is less than 1.0040.

3           5. The school district received basic state aid in fiscal year  
4 2013-2014 and is receiving basic state aid for fiscal year 2014-2015.

5           D. If all the conditions prescribed in subsection C of this section  
6 are met, the school district may submit corrections to teacher experience  
7 index data, no later than August 15, 2015, that are required pursuant to  
8 section 15-941, Arizona Revised Statutes, and the school district may use the  
9 resulting teacher experience index in the determination of its base support  
10 level for fiscal year 2015-2016.




