SENATE BILL 1010

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-1687, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO DISPENSING OPTICIANS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-1687, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-1687. Continuing education

5 A. All dispensing opticians licensed under this chapter shall satisfy
6 a continuing education requirement in accordance with board rules.

7 B. The board shall prescribe by rule the form and content of
8 continuing education for dispensing opticians licensed under this chapter
9 that is designed to educate the licensee in current developments, skills and
10 procedures. Opticians may satisfy this continuing education requirement by
11 home study courses or attending seminars and are not required to join a
12 professional association of dispensing opticians in this state in order to
13 fulfill the requirement. The rules shall establish the number of hours of
14 continuing education required within a three-year period in an amount not to
15 exceed ~~twelve~~ TWENTY-ONE hours.
