1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 15-218, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 15-218. Suicide awareness and prevention training; child abuse
5 and sexual abuse prevention and training; continuing
6 education
7 A. The state board of education shall adopt rules to allow
8 certificated teachers and administrators to count suicide awareness and
9 prevention training programs as continuing education credits.
10 B. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT RULES TO ALLOW
11 CERTIFICATED TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS TO COUNT AWARENESS AND PREVENTION
12 TRAINING ON ISSUES CONCERNING CHILD ABUSE AND THE SEXUAL ABUSE OF CHILDREN,
13 INCLUDING WARNING SIGNS THAT A CHILD MAY BE A VICTIM OF CHILD ABUSE OR SEXUAL
14 ABUSE, AS CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS.
