# **SENATE BILL 1320**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-506, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COSMETOLOGY.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-506, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 32-506. Nonapplicability of chapter

5 This chapter does not apply to the following persons while in the  
6 proper discharge of their professional duties:

7 1. Practices ~~done~~ for the treatment of physical or mental ailments or  
8 disease by medical practitioners licensed pursuant to this title.

9 2. Commissioned physicians and surgeons WHO ARE serving in the armed  
10 forces of the United States or other federal agencies.

11 3. Persons WHO ARE licensed pursuant to chapter 3 or 12 of this title.

12 4. Students WHO ARE attending schools licensed pursuant to this  
13 chapter while they are on school premises during school hours.

14 5. Persons employed by theatrical groups who apply makeup, oils and  
15 cosmetics.

16 6. Persons who sell makeup, oils and cosmetics and who apply such  
17 products during the process of selling such products.

18 7. Shampoo assistants who shampoo hair under the direction of a  
19 cosmetologist licensed pursuant to this chapter.

20 8. Services performed by and for persons in the custody of the state  
21 department of corrections.

22 9. Persons who apply makeup, oils and cosmetics to patients in a  
23 hospital, nursing home or residential care institution with the consent of  
24 the patient and the hospital, nursing home or residential care institution.

25 10. Persons who provide a service that results in tension on hair  
26 strands or roots by twisting, wrapping, weaving, extending, locking or  
27 braiding, if the service does not include the application of dyes, reactive  
28 chemicals or other preparations to alter the color of the hair or to  
29 straighten, curl or alter the structure of the hair.

30 11. Persons who provide threading.

31 12. Persons who provide tanning services by means of airbrushing,  
32 tanning beds or spray tanning.

33 13. PERSONS WHO APPLY MAKEUP, INCLUDING EYELASH ENHANCEMENTS. THIS  
34 PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY IF A PERSON IS ENGAGING IN THE PRACTICE OF  
35 AESTHETICS OR COSMETOLOGY. A PERSON WHO IS EXEMPT PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH  
36 SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY POST A SIGN IN THE PERSON'S PLACE OF BUSINESS NOTIFYING  
37 THE PUBLIC THAT THE PERSON'S SERVICES ARE NOT REGULATED BY THE BOARD.
