# **HOUSE BILL 2350**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 20-288, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO INSURANCE  
PRODUCER LICENSING.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 20-288, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 20-288. Exemption from examination

5 A. An individual who applies for an insurance producer license in this  
6 state and who was previously licensed for the same lines of authority in  
7 another state is not required to take an examination if either:

8 1. The applicant is currently licensed in the other state.

9 2. The application is received within ninety days after the  
10 cancellation of the resident license that the applicant held in another state  
11 and the other state issues a certification that, at the time of cancellation,  
12 the applicant was in good standing in that state, or other reliable  
13 information available to the director indicates that the applicant is or was  
14 licensed in good standing for the line of authority requested. This  
15 paragraph does not apply to an applicant who fails an examination  
16 administered by this state for a specific line of authority four times within  
17 a twelve-month period, who becomes licensed as a resident in another state  
18 for the specific line of authority and who cancels the license in the other  
19 state and applies for a resident license in this state within one year of the  
20 last examination administered to the applicant by this state for the specific  
21 line of authority.

22 B. The following applicants are not required to take an examination:

23 1. An applicant for timely renewal of a license.

24 2. An applicant for the same type of license that covers the same  
25 lines of authority for which the applicant was licensed in this state, other  
26 than under a temporary license, within the twelve months preceding the date  
27 of application.

28 3. An applicant for a ~~limited lines travel~~ AN insurance producer  
29 ~~business entity license, or a travel retailer working under the travel~~  
30 ~~insurance producer business entity license, that is issued pursuant to~~  
31 ~~section 20-333~~ WITH AUTHORITY FOR LIMITED LINE INSURANCE AS DEFINED IN  
32 SECTION 20-281.

33 4. An applicant for a license as a nonresident insurance producer who  
34 meets the requirements of section 20-287, subsection A.

35 5. An applicant for a rental car agent license that is issued pursuant  
36 to section 20-331.

37 6. An applicant for a self-service storage agent license that is  
38 issued pursuant to section 20-332.

39 7. An applicant who resides in a state that does not license adjusters  
40 and who will be only adjusting portable electronics insurance policy claims  
41 in this state.
