SENATE BILL 1210

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 1-255; AMENDING SECTION 41-1304.02, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO STATUTORY DRAFTING AND REVISION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 1, chapter 2, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 1-255, to read:

4 1-255. Adopting statute by reference; subsequent amendments

5 A REFERENCE TO A STATUTE OR PORTION OF A STATUTE APPLIES TO ALL
6 REENACTMENTS, REVISIONS OR AMENDMENTS OF THE STATUTE OR PORTION OF THE
7 STATUTE.

8 Sec. 2. Section 41-1304.02, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
9 read:

10 41-1304.02. Preparing the statutes for publication; revisions

11 A. The director of the Arizona legislative council, in carrying out
12 ~~the provisions of~~ section 41-1304.01, subsection A, paragraphs 2 and 4 AND 5,
13 shall not alter the sense, meaning or effect of any law but may:

14 1. Renumber sections and parts of sections of newly enacted text.

15 2. Rearrange sections, parts of sections, articles, chapters and
16 titles.

17 3. Change reference numbers to agree with renumbered sections, parts
18 of sections, articles, chapters or titles.

19 4. Substitute the proper section, article, chapter or title for the
20 terms "the preceding section", "this article",— AND "this act" and similar
21 terms.

22 5. SUBSTITUTE THE ACTUAL DATE FOR THE TERMS "THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
23 THIS SECTION" AND "THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS AMENDMENT TO THIS SECTION" AND
24 SIMILAR TERMS.

25 ~~5.~~ 6. Strike out figures where they are merely a repetition of
26 written words.

27 ~~6.~~ 7. Change capitalization for the purpose of uniformity.

28 ~~7.~~ 8. Correct manifest clerical, typographical and electronic ~~data~~
29 ~~base~~ DATABASE errors in statutory and nonstatutory text.

30 B. The director shall:

31 1. Omit from the statutes all temporary laws, all titles to acts, all
32 enacting and repealing clauses, all declarations of emergency, and all
33 purpose, validity and construction clauses unless, from their nature, it may
34 be necessary to retain some of them to preserve the full meaning and intent
35 of the law.

36 2. Include in the statutes any provision that was enacted as temporary
37 law but that, by its nature, will have continuing application or effect.

38 C. The director shall not undertake to make any change of:

39 1. Existing laws, it being the intention of this section that the
40 director shall in no manner assume to exercise legislative power.

41 2. A provision that is subject to a referendum until the provision
42 becomes law as provided in the Constitution of Arizona.

43 Sec. 3. Retroactivity

44 Section 41-1304.02, Arizona Revised Statutes as amended by this act,
45 applies retroactivity to from and after April 20, 2015.
