HOUSE RESOLUTION 2004

A RESOLUTION

PROCLAIMING MAY 12, 2015 AS FIBROMYALGIA AWARENESS DAY IN ARIZONA.

1 Whereas, fibromyalgia is a chronic pain disorder that affects over ten
2 million people in the United States as a primary illness, and millions more
3 as a secondary illness; and

4 Whereas, fibromyalgia is a condition that affects the central nervous
5 system and causes debilitating pain in women, men and children of all
6 ethnicities; and

7 Whereas, there is currently no cure for fibromyalgia; and

8 Whereas, patients with fibromyalgia live with widespread pain, sleep
9 disorders, extreme fatigue, stiffness, weakness, numbness and tingling,
10 headaches, and impairment of memory and concentration; and

11 Whereas, patients with fibromyalgia often have coexisting conditions,
12 which may include chronic myofascial pain, migraines, environmental
13 sensitivities, anxiety and depression; and

14 Whereas, it may take years to receive a diagnosis of fibromyalgia, and
15 medical professionals frequently are inadequately educated on the current
16 research, diagnosis and treatment of fibromyalgia, resulting in many
17 undiagnosed cases; and

18 Whereas, increased awareness and expanded knowledge of the realities of
19 living with fibromyalgia will allow the community at large to better support
20 people who struggle with the challenges of this chronic and painful disorder.
21 Therefore

22 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona:

23 That the Members of the House of Representatives proclaim May 12, 2015
24 as Fibromyalgia Awareness Day in the State of Arizona.




