# **HOUSE BILL 2292**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-322, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 32, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 32-329; RELATING TO BARBERS:

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Section 32-322, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:  
4 32-322. Barber license; application; qualifications;  
5 reciprocity  
6 A. An applicant for a barber license shall file the following with the  
7 board:  
8 1. A written application on a form prescribed by the board.  
9 2. Evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant possesses the  
10 necessary qualifications.  
11 3. One signed photograph.  
12 B. Each applicant shall:  
13 1. Be at least sixteen years of age.  
14 2. ~~Have completed~~ COMPLETE and ~~received~~ RECEIVE appropriate credits  
15 for at least two years of high school education or its equivalent as  
16 prescribed by the board in its rules AND SUBMIT SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT  
17 THE PERSON IS AT LEAST SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE.  
18 3. Pass an examination given under the direction of the board.  
19 4. Pay the prescribed fees.  
20 5. Be a graduate of a school THAT IS licensed pursuant to this chapter  
21 or a graduate of a school or program in another state ~~which~~ THAT at the time  
22 of ~~his~~ THE APPLICANT'S graduation met the barber licensing requirements of  
23 that state.  
24 C. An applicant who holds a valid license to practice barbering issued  
25 by another state ~~which~~ THAT has, in the opinion of the board, licensure  
26 requirements that are substantially equivalent to the requirements of this  
27 state and ~~which~~ THAT grants similar reciprocal privileges to barbers licensed  
28 by this state and who has at least one year's experience as a licensed barber  
29 is exempt from subsection B, paragraph 3 OF THIS SECTION.  
30 D. Notwithstanding subsection B, paragraph 5 OF THIS SECTION, an  
31 applicant for a barber license who holds a cosmetologist license issued  
32 pursuant to chapter 5 of this title shall complete a seven hundred ~~fifty hour~~  
33 FIFTY-HOUR course of study consisting of barbering techniques in a barbering  
34 school licensed pursuant to this chapter.  
35 Sec. 2. Title 32, chapter 3, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
36 amended by adding section 32-329, to read:  
37 32-329. Schools; postsecondary educational institutions  
38 A SCHOOL SHALL BE RECOGNIZED AS A POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION  
39 IF BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:  
40 1. THE SCHOOL ADMITS AS REGULAR STUDENTS ONLY INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE  
41 EARNED A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR THE EQUIVALENT OF A RECOGNIZED  
42 HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR WHO ARE BEYOND THE AGE OF COMPULSORY EDUCATION AS  
43 PROVIDED BY SECTION 15-802.  
44 2. THE SCHOOL IS LICENSED BY NAME BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO  
45 OFFER ONE OR MORE TRAINING PROGRAMS BEYOND THE SECONDARY SCHOOL LEVEL.






