SENATE BILL 1326

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2013, CHAPTER 220, SECTION 7; RELATING TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 2013, chapter 220, section 7 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 7. Behavioral health services; accountability measures;
4 reports

5 A. Beginning on the last day of the month following the effective date
6 of this act through December 31, ~~2015~~ 2018, the ~~department of health services~~
7 ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM ADMINISTRATION shall prepare and
8 issue a quarterly financial and program accountability trends report to the
9 governor, the chairpersons of the house of representatives health and ~~reform~~
10 ~~and human services~~ CHILDREN AND FAMILY AFFAIRS committees, the chairperson of
11 the senate health and human services committee, the director of the joint
12 legislative budget committee and the director of the governor's office of
13 strategic planning and budgeting. The ~~department~~ ADMINISTRATION shall
14 provide a copy of each report to the secretary of state. The report shall
15 use the following accountability factors by geographic service areas for
16 children enrolled in the comprehensive medical and dental program:

17 1. The number and ~~per cent~~ PERCENTAGE of children in the comprehensive
18 medical and dental program who have received behavioral health services,
19 excluding the original assessment, through a regional behavioral health
20 authority as of the end of each month.

21 2. The number of new behavioral health cases opened each month, the
22 total number of cases that remain open from the current and previous months
23 and the total number of cases that have been closed each month.

24 3. The type of behavioral health services the children received and
25 the costs of each of those services.

26 4. The number of notices of action received and for what reason and
27 the outcome of those notices.

28 5. The number of notice of appeals filed and for what reason, the
29 outcomes of those appeals by the administrative law judge and the final
30 decisions reached by the director of the Arizona health care cost containment
31 system ~~administration~~.

32 B. Beginning on the last day of the month following the effective date
33 of this act through December 31, ~~2015~~ 2018, the department of ~~economic~~
34 ~~security~~ CHILD SAFETY shall issue a quarterly financial and program
35 accountability trend report to the governor, the chairpersons of the house of
36 representatives health and ~~reform and human services~~ CHILDREN AND FAMILY
37 AFFAIRS committees, the chairperson of the senate health and human services
38 committee, the director of the joint legislative budget committee and the
39 director of the governor's office of strategic planning and budgeting. The
40 department shall submit a copy of each report to the secretary of state.
41 Each report shall use the following accountability factors by county:

42 1. The number and ~~per cent~~ PERCENTAGE of children who are in foster
43 care and who are title XIX eligible as of the end of that month.

1 2. The number of new title XIX eligible children opened in that month,
2 the total number of children that remain open from the current and previous
3 months and the total number of children who have been closed in that month.

4 3. The amount of nontitle XIX expenditures by service type used by the
5 department to supplement the behavioral health services received through the
6 regional behavioral health authorities.

7 Sec. 2. Retroactivity

8 This act applies retroactively to from and after December 30, 2015.
