HOUSE BILL 2435

AN ACT

ALLOWING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO CORRECT OVERSTATEMENTS OF DAILY ROUTE MILEAGE.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. School district overstatements of daily route
3 mileage; correction; interest; resolution

4 A. Notwithstanding sections 15-905 and 15-915, Arizona Revised
5 Statutes, a school district that overstated its daily route mileage during
6 fiscal years 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 shall correct the
7 overstatement over a three-year period beginning in fiscal year 2016-2017 and
8 ending in fiscal year 2018-2019. The repayment amount shall be paid in equal
9 installments in each of the three fiscal years. This subsection applies to a
10 school district if all of the following conditions exist:

11 1. The school district is a common school district.

12 2. The school district's average daily membership for fiscal year
13 2014-2015 was more than one hundred pupils but less than one hundred fifty
14 pupils.

15 3. The total amount of the overstatement is more than two hundred
16 thousand dollars but less than two hundred fifty thousand dollars.

17 B. In addition to monies required to be repaid pursuant to
18 subsection A of this section, accrued interest must be paid at a rate
19 determined by the superintendent of public instruction.

20 C. The governing board of a school district to which this section
21 applies shall adopt a formal resolution to comply with this section and, if
22 requested by the department of education, submit to annual daily route
23 mileage audits.

24 Sec. 2. Emergency

25 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
26 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
27 law.
